<p>CME Requirements At-A-Glance</p>	<p>Renewal cycle: Biennial registration by June 1 of even-numbered years</p> <p>Minimum CMEs: 40 Category 1 CME every two-year renewal cycle</p> <p>State-mandated CME content</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 4 CME on current topics of concern: Ethics, Risk Management, Opioid Pain Management/Chronic Pain Management, End of Life/Palliative Care, and/or Antimicrobial Stewardship
<p>State-Mandated CME Content Detail</p>	<p>At least 4 hours of continuing medical education shall be earned on topics of current concern as determined by the director of the Rhode Island Department of Health. Current topics include: Ethics, Risk Management, Opioid pain management / chronic pain management, End of life / palliative care, Antimicrobial Stewardship.</p>
